Your instructor is not there to drive your vehicle but rather lead, guide, and direct you to better handle your vehicle while driving in a closed, controlled environment.

Your instructor will provide you with feedback about your driving skill in a constructive positive manner. They will determine if you are ready to drive solo. They will also determine if you are ready to move up to a different group. This will depend on the skills and efforts you have demonstrated to them while driving the road course. Feel free to discuss any problems or concerns you have with your instructor; they are here to help you become a better driver. You must first get permission from your instructor to move up into another run group and then consult an event organizer, for final approval.
