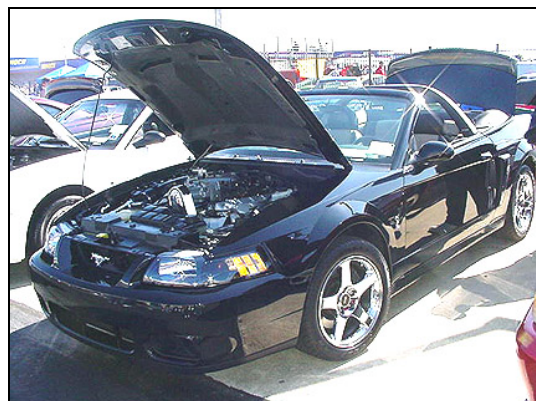


(Kerry and Andrew McSwain brought their father/son 94/95 Cobra twins with them.)
